Why a joint CME Conference for OBGyns & Pediatricians?

This first-ever joint meeting between the Georgia Obstetrical and Gynecological Society and the Georgia Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics is intended to examine several topics common to both specialties in maternal, newborn and adolescent care. Improved collaboration can result in better care for both mother and baby. Viewing them as a dyad can also optimize care. In areas such as post-partum depression and adolescent gynecology, both specialties have roles to play. Coordination of this care can yield better outcomes and efficacy.

Who Should Attend

The Winter Symposium is open to all obstetricians/gynecologists and pediatricians and clinical staff who work in those offices, and public health professionals working in maternal, infant and adolescent health.
