# What is Project ECHO®?

Project ECHO® (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes) is an innovative project that uses a virtual model of health care delivery and education, by linking expert specialist at a "hub" with primary care providers in local communities "spokes." Together, they participate in twice a month ECHO® clinics, which are virtual education sessions, combined with mentoring and patient case presentations. This is an educational approach that differs from telemedicine; as ECHO® clinics focus on tele-mentoring & education rather than direct clinical care.

# How does ECHO® work?

This project is designed to expand the capacity of primary care physicians to provide evidence-based, pediatric growth & endocrinology care in Georgia. Our lead faculty is Farah Khatoon, DO, MPH, a pediatric endocrinologist at Navicent Health–The Children's Hospital in Macon, GA. This program offers a complimentary 1 hr. approved CME didactic education per clinic (A maximum 8 CME Credits per learning session), and case-based learning in an effort to train & support community physicians with state-of-the-art virtual technology. Each 4 month learning session will feature 8 didactic clinics offered twice a month.

# Why should practices consider ECHO®?

Although children and youth represent one of the fastest growing populations affected by growth & endocrine problems, many communities have little or no access to pediatric endocrinologist. Using secure videoconferencing technology, the twice a month ECHO® clinic links specialist with community providers in a collaborative educational approach. The twice a month clinics include brief updates on pediatric growth & endocrinology topics as well as presentation of de-identified cases and recommendations.
