What is Project ECHO®?

Project ECHO® (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes) is an innovative project that uses a virtual model of health care education, by linking expert specialist at a "hub" with primary care providers in local community practice "spokes." Together, they participate in twice a month ECHO® videoconference clinics, combined with mentoring and patient case studies. This is an educational approach that differs from telemedicine; as ECHO® clinics focus on tele-mentoring & education rather than direct clinical care.

How does ECHO® work?

This project is designed to expand the capacity of primary care practices to provide evidence-based, pediatric growth & endocrinology care in Georgia. Our lead faculty is Farah Khatoon, DO, MPH, a pediatric endocrinologist at Navicent Health–The Children's Hospital in Macon, GA. This program offers a complimentary 1 hr. approved CME & Nurse Contact Hours per clinic (A maximum 8 Credits per learning session), and case-based learning in an effort to train & support community physicians & staff with virtual technology. Each 4 month learning session will feature 8 didactic clinics offered twice a month.

Who should participate?

We encourage all primary care providers & staff including: pediatricians, family physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, nurses, and medical assistants to participate.
