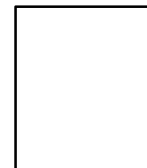

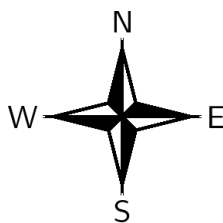

Directions to the Capitol / Floyd Building:

(2 Martin Luther King Dr, Atlanta, GA 30334 - Floyd Bldg. is across the street from the Capitol at its NE corner.)

From the South: Take I-75/85 North to Exit 245 (Capitol Ave). At the bottom of the exit ramp, continue straight through the stop sign. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Hank Aaron Dr. The Capitol will be approximately 1 mile down on the left.

From the North: Take I-75/85 South to Exit 248A (Martin Luther King, Jr. Dr). Bear right onto MLK Jr. Dr. The Capitol will be on the left.



From the East: Take I-20 West to Exit 58A (Capitol Ave). Turn right on Capitol Ave. The Capitol will be approximately one mile down on the left.

From the West: Take I-20 East to Exit 56B (Windsor St./Spring St./Stadium). At the 3rd light, turn left onto Central Avenue. Go to Mitchell St & turn right. The Capitol will be 2 blocks down on the left.

Nearby Parking Lots:

Pete Hackney Lot: 162 Jesse Hill Jr Dr. - at the corner of Jesse Hill Dr & Decatur St - Max Height 8', 2" (\$5 Flat Rate, Cash/Credit)

Steve Polk Plaza Lot 302: 65 MLK Jr Dr. - at the corner of MLK Jr. Dr. & Washington, beside old World of Coca-Cola Bldg. (\$13 Rate, Cash/Credit)
