Getting to Amelia Island

Amelia Island is located off the northeasternmost tip of Florida on the Atlantic Ocean and separated from Georgia only by the Cumberland Sound. Amelia Island is just 15 miles east of Interstate 95, and is a short, 30minute drive from Jacksonville International Airport. The island is located adjacent to the community of Fernandina Beach, Fla.

Access by car: From 1-95: Take I-95 to Exit 373 (old 129), turn east onto A1A, travel 15 miles crossing the Intracoastal Waterway onto Amelia Island.

Arriving by air: Driving from the Jacksonville Airport: Exit the airport on the access road and travel approximately 2 miles to 1-95. Take I-95 north for approximately 9 miles to Exit 373. Take Exit 373 (old 129) and proceed east on Highway A1A to Amelia Island.
