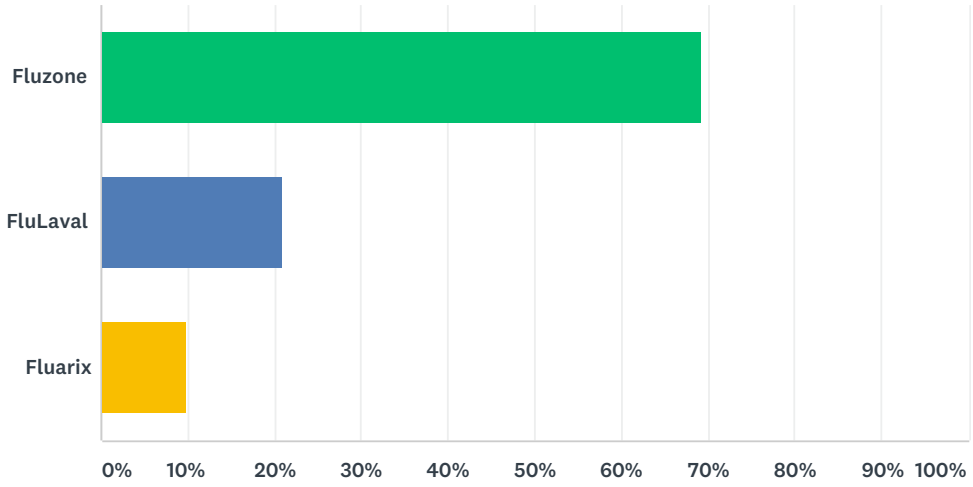


Q1 During this influenza season, which vaccines did you administer in your practice? (Check all that apply)

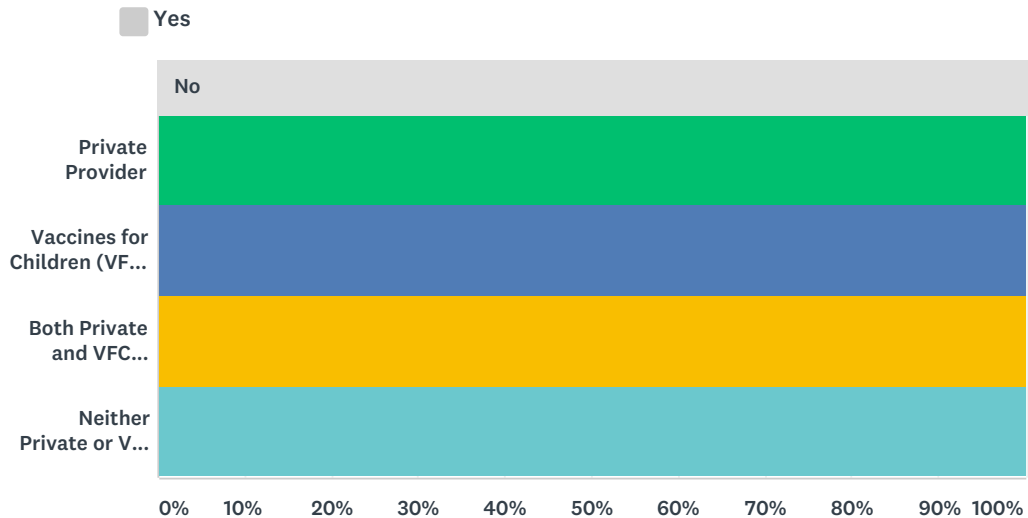
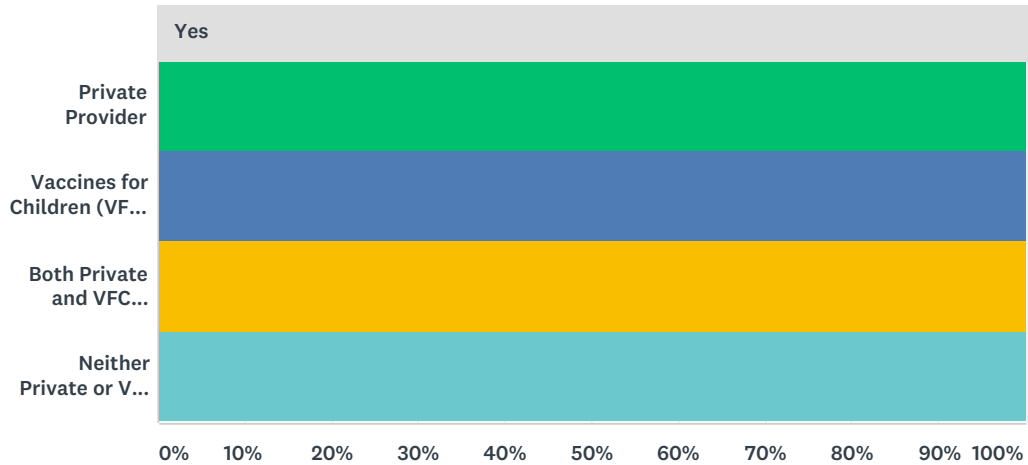

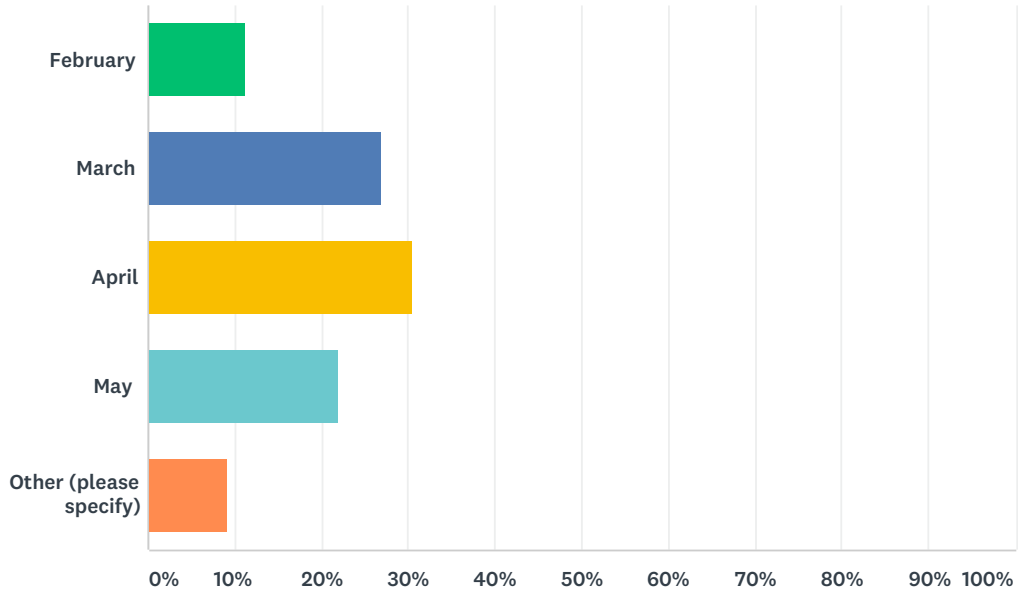

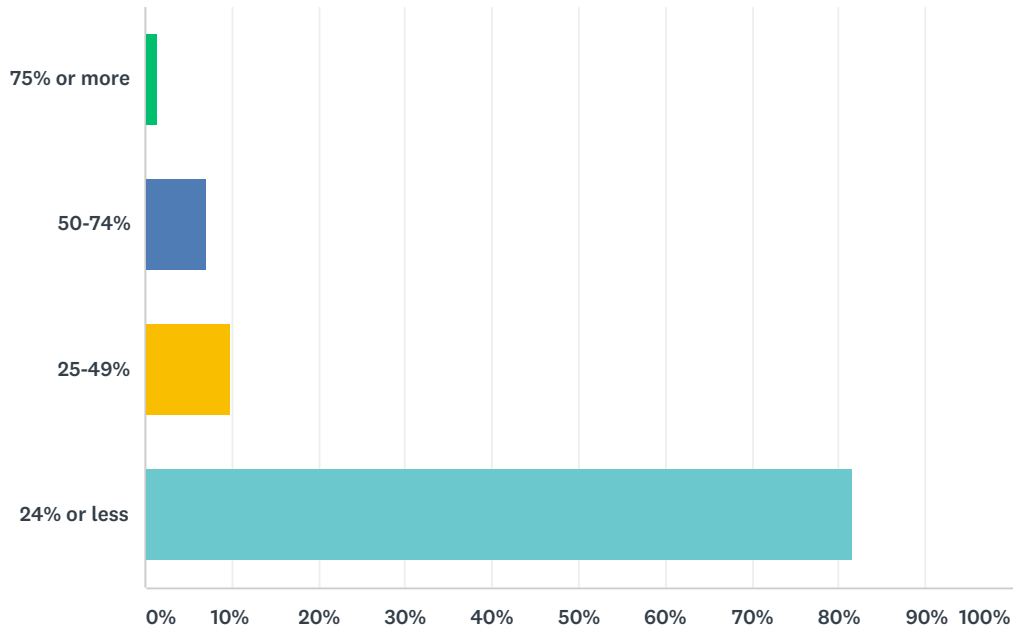

Q11 How many of your patients do you estimate received influenza vaccine at retail clinics?

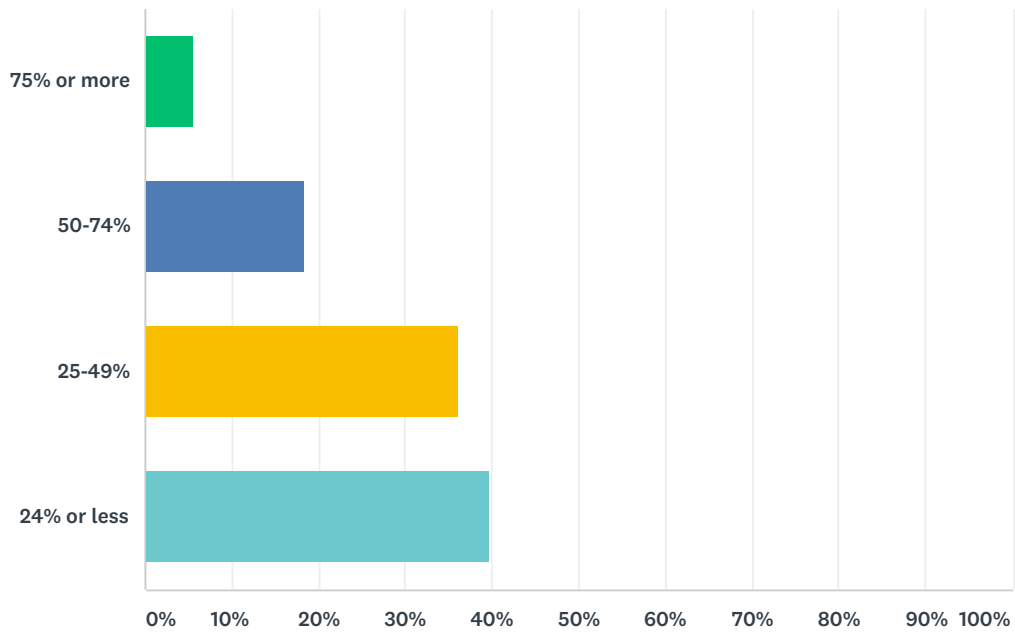

Q12 What percentage of your patients received a diagnosis of influenza during this season?

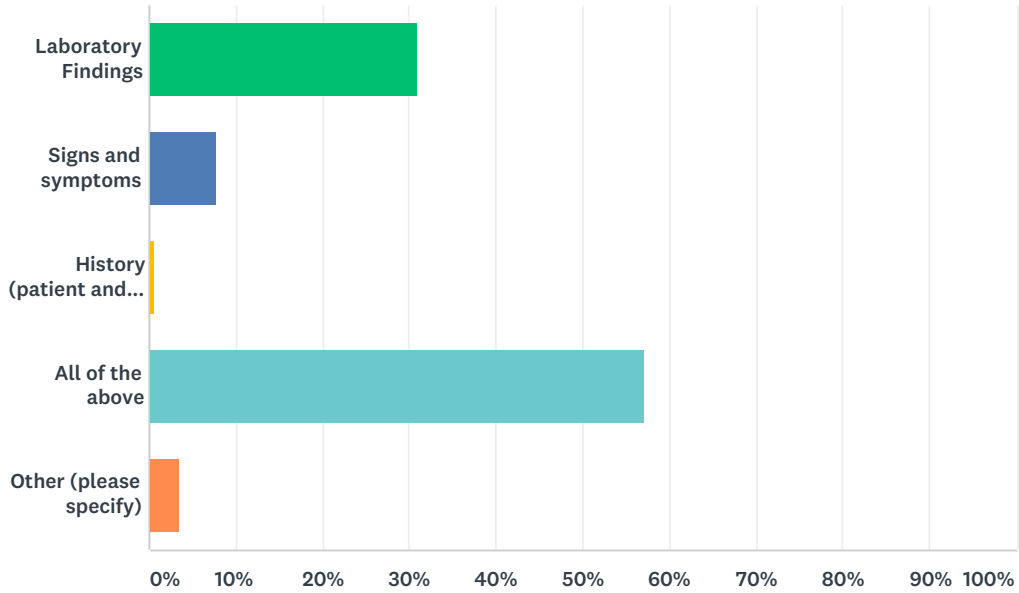

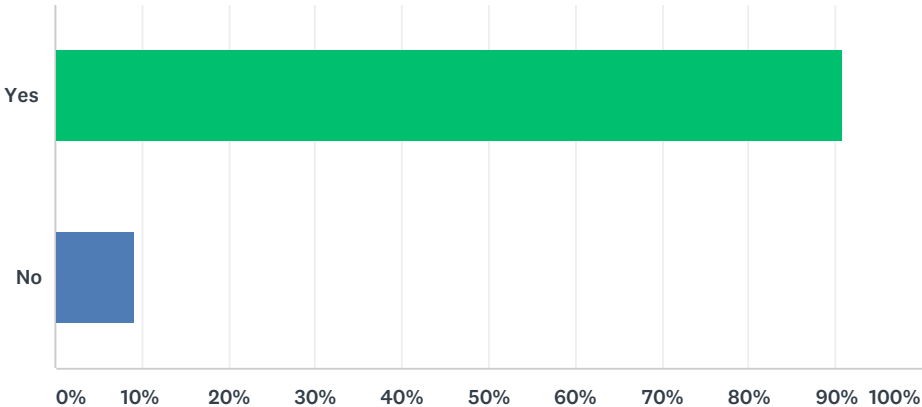

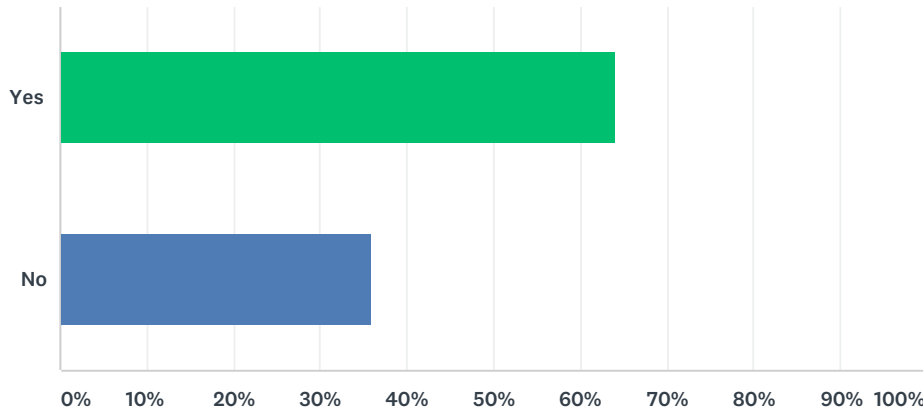
